# HUDSON VALLEY 10-13 ASSOCIATION, Inc. CONSTITUTION \& BY-LAWS 

This is the revised Constitution \& By-Laws.<br>Please review as it will come to a vote at the next General Membership Meeting. (December 21, 2023)

## ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP
Section 2 - Member in Good Standing defined:
Any member whose dues are current, for more than three (3) years and has paid dues for more than three (3) years and who abides by, and does not intentionally violate, the Constitution \& By-Laws of this Association shall be considered a member in good standing. Members should keep their contact information up to date annually.

Section 3 - There shall be the following classes of members:
Regular Members: Any honorably retired or active member of the Department who is interested in furthering the objective of the Association may be considered by the Membership Committee and recommended to, and approved by a majority vote, the membership at any scheduled meeting. (remove) - Any Regular Member who has attained the age of 75 shall be considered_a Life Member and no longer required to pay dues. Any Regular Member being considered for Life Membership must have at least three (3) consecutive years of membership, in good standing, immediately preceding their eligibility. Active members of the Department do not have the right to vote or hold office until they have achieved retirement status. All Officers, Board Members, Committee Members and other elected or appointed officials must be active Regular Members in good standing.

Honorary Members: All honorable persons recommended as Honorary Members of the Association may be considered by the Membership Committee and recommended to and approved by a majority vote of the Board of Officers and approved by a majority vote of the Membership at any scheduled meeting. Such members shall have no rights,
duties or obligations in the management of the Association. An Honorary Member is not required to pay dues, because of his special standing and relationship with the Association.

Associate Members: All honorable persons that could not ordinarily be considered for membership as regular Members but are interested in furthering the objective of this Association may be considered for Associate Membership. Upon recommendation by the Membership Committee as an Associate Member, the candidate shall be screened at a duly held meeting of the Board of Officers and approved by a majority vote of the Membership at any scheduled meeting. Such Member shall have no rights, duties, or obligations, in the management of the Association. An Associate Member will be required to pay the same dues as regular members.

## ARTICLE IV

## DUES

Section 1 - The annual membership dues shall be in the amount of $\mathbf{\$ 3 5 . 0 0}$ payable January $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$, each year. This amount may be changed upon the recommendation of the Board of Officers to the General Membership, who will vote upon such change at the October membership meeting. A straight majority vote is required of all Members present, and in good standing, to ratify any dues increase. Upon ratification, this dues increase will become effective the following year.

## ARTICLE V

## FUNDS

Section 2 - Between regular meetings the President is empowered to advance up to $\$ 500.00$ in emergencies relating to the interest of the Association.

## ARTICLE VI

## MEETINGS

SECTION 1-Membership meetings shall be held at a time and place to be fixed by the President. Notice of such a meeting shall be given by mail or email to each Member of the Association. Twelve (12) members shall constitute a quorum and shall be deemed sufficient to conduct the business of the Association.

SECTION 2 - Meetings may be called by the President whenever in his/her judgement he/she deems it to be in the best interest of the Association to do so. Any Member in good standing may petition the President to call a special meeting, stating in brief the subject matter which in their opinion calls for a special meeting. The President shall direct the Corresponding secretary to notify all Members of the Association by mail or email of such special meeting at least seven (7) days before such meeting is scheduled. No business shall be transacted at a special meeting other than that for which the special meeting is called.

## ARTICLE VII

QUORUM
Section 1 - The presence of six (6) Members of the Board of Officers shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business provided one of the six present is the President or Vice President.

## ARTICLE X

1 ${ }^{\text {sI }}$ SERGEANT AT ARMS
Section 9
( c ) The Sergeant at Arms is responsible for maintaining decorum, security and protection of the Members and visiting guests. He/she will, on the direction of the presiding officer, remove any Member not maintaining proper decorum.
(d) (remove) - Be responsible for the security of all documents of the Association.

## $\underline{2}^{\text {nd }}$ SERGEANT AT ARMS

(b) In the absence of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Sergeant at Arms he/she shall assume the duties of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Sergeant at Arms.

## ARTICLE XVI

Section 1
( d ) This Constitution and By-Laws shall be reviewed for possible amendments or revisions every five (5) years starting in January 2023. A By-Laws Committee consisting of three (3) Members will be appointed by the President allowing enough time to conduct the review and bring any changes to the Executive Board for review. A copy of this Constitution and ByLaws shall be made available to every Member in good standing.

## ARTICLE XVII

## DEATH OF A MEMBER

Section 1-A wake is a solemn and memorable way to commemorate the lives of those who have served in the NYPD. The purpose of the wake is to be a formal and respectful event, which includes proper etiquette on the part of the Members.
( a ) The President, in his/her sole discretion, has the authority to initiate a wake detail upon the death of a Member.
( b ) The detail will consist of Members of the Association.
( c ) The ceremony will be conducted by the Chaplain or Assistant Chaplain.
( d ) Members of the detail shall wear blue jacket, white shirt, gray pants, and a blue tie.
