
As you may know, the Police Pension Fund began a multi-phase strategic initiative to replace our pension administration system with a new system that automates business processes. As a result, retirees now have access to new self-service features in their webCOPS accounts.

If you haven't already, we encourage you to create a webCOPS account at https://webcopsmss.v3locity.com where you can view benefit history, change direct deposit information, and tax withholding, request an award letter, and more.




National 10-13 President Mike Fahy and VP Rich Molloy meet with Sen Harckham in Albany to discuss the Health Benefits Bill (S8388)
