Dear Police Pension Fund Recipient,

This is the last printed quarterly statement you will receive.

To reduce paper waste and streamline services, your quarterly statements will no longer be printed and mailed to you. You will continue to receive a printed and mailed copy of your annual IRS Form 1099-R.

As you may know, the Police Pension Fund began a multi-phase strategic initiative to replace our pension administration system with a new system that automates business processes. As a result, retirees now have access to new self-service features in their webCOPS accounts.

If you haven't already, we encourage you to create a webCOPS account at <https://webcopsmss.v3locity.com> where you can view benefit history, change direct deposit information, and tax withholding, request an award letter, and more.

For retirees who chose not to sign up for webCOPS, a request may be made for the information formerly contained in the quarterly statement at any time by sending a written request to PPF at: NYC Police Pension Fund
