MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT IS OCT 15TH THRU DEC 7TH 2025

Mark your calendars, the Medicare Open Enrollment starts October 15, 2025. Did you know that new benefits are coming to Medicare drug coverage next year?

Starting in 2026 all Medicare plans will include a **\$2100.00 cap on what you pay out-of-pocket for prescription drugs** covered by your plan.

Also starting next year you can choose to participate in a program that spreads your out-of-pocket drug costs across the calendar year instead of paying all at once at the pharmacy. It's called the **Medicare Prescription Payment Plan** and you can opt in with your plan through out the 2026 plan year. Contact your plan for more details.

Remember, Medicare plans can change from one year to the next, and so can your health needs. Preview and compare all your health and drug options and see if you can save !

There are no words of comfort at such a difficult time; however, if you have all the necessary information ready it will expedite any claim that is pending and make the process run smoothly.

Death of a Retired Uniformed Member

Upon the death of a Retired Uniformed Member, contact the NYPD Operations Unit, located at One Police Plaza, at 646-610-5580.

NYC Transit or Housing Police Departments, Prior to May 1995

For Police Officers who worked for the NYC Transit or Housing Police Departments and retired prior to May 1995, please contact New York City Employee Retirement System (NYCERS) at 347-643-3000.

Required Information

You will have to provide the deceased's:

First, middle, and last name

The date of death

Social security number

Next of kin as well as the executor/trix of the estate and his/her address and phone number

To complete our records, you will need:

The original or certified copy of the death certificate

Certified copy of your marriage certificate as well as your social security number

These documents are necessary for any benefits that might be due to you as per the members chosen option.

Retired Member's Line Organization

Contact the appropriate Union for a possible existing life insurance policy as well as possible continuation of optional benefits, if qualified.
